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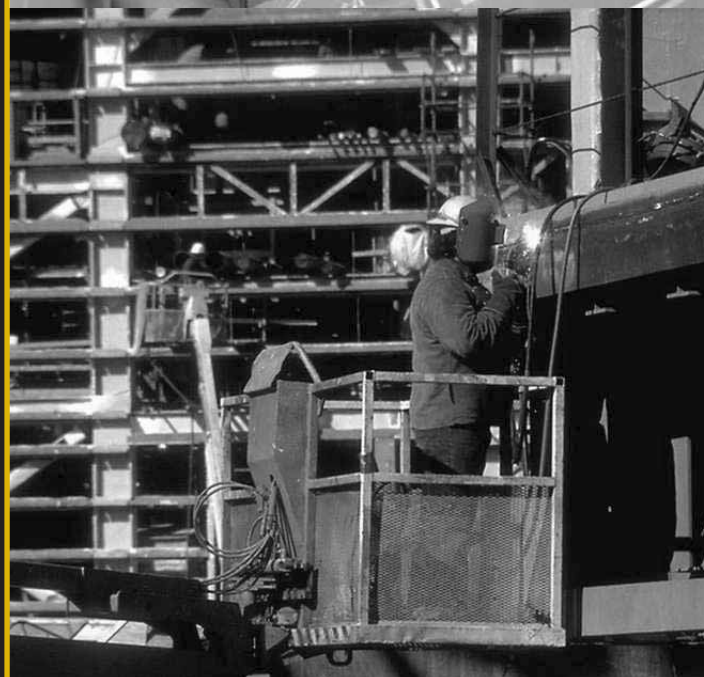

ISA's Certified Industrial Maintenance Mechanic® (CIMM®) Program



History of CIMM

In response to industry requests, ISA developed a certification program for industrial maintenance mechanics in 2004. ISA certification as a CIMM® will provide a non-biased, third-party, objective assessment and confirmation of the skills of a companies' industrial maintenance mechanics. For maintenance mechanics, the CIMM® program provides an opportunity to stand out from the crowd and be recognized.

CIMM®s are responsible for preventive, predictive, and corrective maintenance. They perform troubleshooting and analysis, and apply sound maintenance practices in all aspects of their work. CIMM®s are multi-skilled individuals whose expertise is primarily mechanical in nature as opposed to instrumentation or electrical.

Exam Development

The development of a valid examination for the CIMM certification process began with a clear and concise definition of the knowledge, skills, and abilities needed for competent job performance. Using interviews, surveys, obser-



vation, and group discussions, ISA worked with maintenance practitioners to delineate critical job components into four performance domains, and then further into tasks and skills. Visit www.isa.org/cimm and follow the left-hand navigation menu to the link for Domains.

The knowledge and skill bases for the questions on the examination were derived from the actual practice of the maintenance mechanic as outlined in the 2004 CIMM Role Delineation Study. To review the CIMM Job Analysis report which includes all information compiled to develop the program and the test specifications, visit www.isa.org/cimmanalysis.

Exam Specifications

CIMM test specifications were developed by combining the overall survey evaluations of importance, frequency, and criticality, and converting the results into percentages. Importance, frequency, and criticality ratings were weighted equally in this computation. These percentages are used to determine the number of questions related to each domain and task, as shown in the chart below.

Requirements

General criteria to qualify to take the CIMM® examination include a commitment to the ISA Code of Ethics, a completed application with documentation included to support the education and experience requirements, and the application fee. Applicants must meet the qualifications outlined below to be eligible to sit for the CIMM® exam.

Related Work Experience

Related work experience means a minimum of five years of relevant work experience in the maintenance mechanic field in an industrial setting (or

three years of relevant work experience if the Education requirement described below is met). One (1) year of work experience means 1,500 hours of active employment. A cumulative total of 7,500 hours of documented work experience is required during the five year period prior to your application date (or 4,500 hours of documented work experience during the five year period prior to your application date for applicants submitting Education documentation).

Education

A two year associate degree in maintenance or a related field from an accredited institution may be used to satisfy two years of the five year work requirement outlined above. A two year apprenticeship program certified through the U.S. Department of Labor will also satisfy this requirement.

Exam Preparation

ISA currently offers the CIMM Study Guide, a three-day instructor led CIMM review course, as well as many CD and online courses in maintenance areas for those that are preparing to take the CIMM exam. An online needs assessment tool is under development at this time and will be available later this summer.

Ted Kucharski of our chapter's Education Committee, submitted Wally Wahlberg's name to Kristy Becker, CMP, Certification Administrator, at the ISA in Research Triangle Park, North Carolina as a candidate to serve on their committee the week of June 11-14, 2007 for producing an examination for Certifying Industrial Maintenance Mechanics. (CIMM) The committee consisted of eight maintenance repair professionals from around the country. They were:

Their task was two fold, qualify 175 preprepared exam questions for validity and then qualify the four multiple choice answers for each of the 175 exam questions. Their input from a broad range of industrial maintenance experiences was incorporated into an exam considered to be fair and practical. Passing grade for certification had been established at 70 percentile. The Examination Moderator, Mr. Vernon Trevathan (of ISA's Professional Development Department) commented after hearing all the discussions on the exam questions and answers, that, "It will be an excellent tool to test maintenance mechanics on what they do know, and, on what the do not know to perform their jobs."

Wally Wahlberg said, "It was an honor to serve on the exam committee and to represent the PFMA and In-Place Machining Company."

Much Ado About Urinals

Alas! You're a facilities manager in charge of plumbing systems and you've just been handed a directive "from the mountain top" signed by the president or board of regents or, worse yet, your boss stating that waterless urinals must be installed in place of the 1.0 gpf urinals that are currently installed. Waterless urinals are part of a group of urinals called High Efficiency Urinals (HEU). HEU's are defined as urinals that flush 0.5gpf or less. Traditional urinals have been proven over a period of many years, the maintenance is quick and in many cases the water and sewer rates are low but in an effort for your institution to save on resources an easy mark has been hit: the urinals. Over the past ten years this scenario has been played out scores and scores of times.

What's at stake? Scarce resources, user satisfaction, money and of course, your job and livelihood. If the wrong recommendation is acted upon, twice as much labor and money can be invested to achieve an impossible result that brings about a high level of user dissatisfaction. On the other hand, when the correct recommendation is taken, water and money can be saved along with a user base that has the same or higher level of satisfaction.

What to do? Engage in a futile battle with those "on the mountain top"? Randomly start writing purchase orders for waterless urinals? How about an old-fashioned performance analysis?

Inherent in a comprehensive analysis is time. Before anything can be done to find out if HEU's are a good fit for your institution you must negotiate for time. Adequate time to make a current assessment of your facilities' urinals, time to study the current HEU technologies, and time to properly test the range of HEU's is imperative. A reasonable time to accomplish this in most cases is nine months. Of course, this will vary depending upon the size of your facilities and the range of usage types (e.g. - 24/7, abusive, light commercial) within these facilities. How can this time be discretized? Let's say 1-3 months to measure your current situation, order samples, and install samples. Then, another six months to test and evaluate samples.

Questions that must be answered about your current situation are: 1. How many urinals are in the facilities? 2. What are the flow volumes (1.0 gpf, 2.0gpf,...)? 3. What are the fixture configurations (quarter stall, standard size, full stall, troughs)? 4. How old are the urinals? 5. What is the drainage pipe material, diameter, slope, age, condition, and configurations (any unusually long horizontal runs or drops)? 6. Where are your facilities geographically located? 7. How are the urinals treated when they are used and how intense or frequent is the usage?

Question 1 addresses cost. If there are thousands of urinals in your facilities then the new urinals will mean a huge investment. Question 2 deals with how much water and, more importantly, how much money can be saved with new, more efficient HEU's. Questions 3-4 deal with labor. If there are many older urinals, the change can mean a big labor expense and complicated installations. Question 5 deals with the bane of all plumbing issues: clogging – what is the likelihood. It's always a good idea to take photographs of drain lines prior to installing any alternative urinals to compare drainage effects brought about by HEU's. Question 6 has to do with the current/future availability of water, how much and how quickly the water/sewer rates will rise over time. This will have a huge impact on your water/money savings calculations. It's important to speak to water department officials in your area. The message may not be good. Finally,

Question 7 deals with your choice of HEU material. Since some HEU's are made from light duty fiberglass, in situations where abuse or vandalism is highly probable, this type of material is not recommended.

OK, so you've taken a "snapshot" of your current situation, now what? Start learning about the different HEU options. There are currently three types HEU options. The first option is 0.5gpf urinals which in many cases can be configured simply from changing the existing diaphragm or piston assembly from the installed urinal systems. Caution is stressed in this scenario. It is very important to test each urinal system configuration to see if complete wash down and trap water exchange is achieved. Every combination of valve type, fixture type, and working pressure will bring about different results.

The second option is waterless urinals. There are two basic designs: 1. Cartridge type which have replaceable trap ways that must be frequently replaced at a cost of \$30-\$40 and 2. Bell trap type urinals which have integral trap ways and require only recharging the fluid seal with a few ounces of a specific fluid sealant. Both types will save enormous amounts of water

but the cartridge type may not save as much or any money due to the continuous cost of buying and installing new trap way cartridges. It's also important to note that while this type of HEU is designed to be without water, the drain

lines are not designed to be without water. The drain lines require water to move the liquid waste and debris down the line. Also, look to see if there is a water source upstream of the waterless urinals to help push the waste downstream. There have been real life studies and university studies that have shown significant drainage problems with waterless urinals. This can have a catastrophic effect!

There are other key aspects to consider such as maintenance, installation, resistance to vandalism and odors. Can you quantify the amount of labor necessary to properly maintain waterless urinals? Is the retrofit installation reasonable? How will the units react to abuse and vandalism? Can the odors be measured, evaluated and mitigated?

The third option is Ultra Low Flow Urinals (ULFU) whose flush volume is as low as 16 ounces per flush. These units have the advantage of washing down the fixture every time to keep odors minimized and keeping the waste flowing down the drainage lines, have the same basic installation procedures, have the same necessary maintenance, and are heavy duty, just like the 1.0 gpf flush urinals that will stand up to abuse and vandalism. What's more, up to 88% of the water can be saved and over the life of the building over \$2000 in

ULFU's are new to the market and have characteristics that best fit most water conservation applications: water savings, durability, easy maintenance, no odors.

Operational costs and recommended applications are very important and should never be overlooked. The above analysis assumes 50 male users with a frequency use of twice daily and a water/sewer rate of \$7.00/1000 gallons.

Document the existing cleanliness, general conditions of the urinals, the drain line conditions and install an entire bank of new HEU's. By thinking out your plan of attack, documenting your results, and objectively analyzing those results you can save your institution much water and money and save your job!
